Niagara Campaign  
1814**

Commanding Officer: Major General Gordon Drummond

1 July 1814

Right Division: deployed as follows:

103rd Regiment of Foot - in Burlington  
Militia - in Burlington  
8th Regiment of Foot - in York  
Glengarry Light Infantry - in York

Niagara Frontier: Brigadier General Phineas Riall

(deployed on west bank of Niagara from Ft. Erie to Ft. George)  
41st Regiment of Foot - in Fort Niagara  
1st Regiment of Foot  
100th Regiment of Foot  
Det/19th Light Dragoons  
Provisional Dragoons (2 troops)  
Lincoln County Militia Flank Companies  
Indians

3 July:

100th Regiment of Foot concentrated at Chippawa

5 July:

8th Regiment of Foot arrives on Niagara River

7th July:

Upper Canada Incorporated Militia deployed between Kingston and Ft Niagara  
89th & 104th Regiments of Foot (Flank Companies only) sent from Kingston to York  
6th, 82nd, & 90th Regiments of Foot ordered from Montreal to Kingston

8 July:

Glengarry Light Infnatry & 300 York Militia arrive at Ft. George

23 July:

Flank Cos/104th Regiment of Foot arrive at 12 Mile Creek and are attached to the 103rd Regiment of Foot

25 July

Major General Drummond & 103rd Regiment fo Foot join Riall's force at Lundy Lane.

29th July:

De Watteville's Regiment of Foot arrives at Ft. Niagara

8 August:

De Watteville's Regiment of Foot, 260 sailors, & Royal Marines besieged in Ft. Erie

18 August:

82nd Regiment of Foot arrives at Ft. Erie  
89th Regiment of Foot deploys between Ft. Niagara & Ft. Erie  
103rd Regiment of Foot withdraws to Ft. George

24 August:

82nd Regiment of Foot arrives in Ft. Erie

2 September:

6th Regiment of Foot arrives at Ft. Erie

8 September:

Flank Cos/104th Regiment of Foot withdraw to Chippawa

18 September:

97th Regiment of Foot arrives at Chippawa

23 September

80th Regiment of Foot arrives at Queenston

19 October:

5 companies of 90th Regiment of Foot land at Burlington

2 November

37th Regiment of Foot and artillery arrive at Ft.  
George
