Notes: In addition to what is shown above, each division had pontoon trains, supply and ammunition columns, hospital, an field telegraph and telephone detachments. The aggregate strength of a mobilized division is over 20,000 men and 6,000 horses.

The 5th Army, commanded by General Kawamura, was mobilized in December 1904, and consisted of second reservists, raised under the new military law. It did not take to the field until January 1905.

Immediately after the surrender of Port Arthur the 3rd Army moved north to Sha-Ho and joined the other armies under the command of Marshal Marquis Oyama.
